



How did I prepare for the Canadian market?

I came to Canada in 2000 to study English and fell in love with the country and people. I was determined to come back to work. I focused mostly on improving my language skills and certifications and/or Education that were recognized globally.

How did I prepare for landing a job at Oracle?

I joined NetSuite in August 2011 when I decided to change my job. I was looking for a Company that allowed me to growth and in which I could be myself and use my native language as an asset. I was in contact with a recruiter and reviewing the opportunities with frequency. Attended multiple interviews, until I got the job offer.

How I started my journey in Canada?

I first visited Toronto during my University years in USA. I arrived to live in Canada in May 2002. An insight from a friend led to filing PR Immigration Paperwork 2 years prior from Brazil. I was hired as an Implementation Consultant for Manufacturing and Distribution by an ERP Vertical Provider.

How did I prepare for the Canadian market?

I was dedicated to good Academic work and improving my fluency in English at my University in USA. My Professors arranged an Internship to be part of the Upjohn & Pharmacia Executive Merger Requirements Meetings. It was a very successful experience, and I had 3 offers to stay.

How did I prepare for the Canadian market?

I got exposure to the Canadian work culture while working on Projects in France and Colombia with Canadian companies. Also, honing my English and French language skills was key, and certifications.

How did I prepare for landing a job at Oracle?

After having 3 Canadian work experiences, I applied for a Project Manager role in the AMP Services vertical in September 2021. I started working on the role in November 2021.

Key points: Knowing your career, and articulating it in a **structured, concise and clear** during the recruitment process.

How I started my journey in Canada?

I arrived in Canada in April 2017 as an entrepreneur – Oracle Gold Partner Consulting Firm – after 9 months I decided to exit the company.

How did I prepare for the Canadian market?

I started attending all possible networking events and joined different non-profit organizations as volunteer (ExaTec/ UnstoppableMe/Xchange Ontario) and participated in mentorship program (Hipanotech/JVS-Triec/Acces Employment)



How does a week look like for me?

I manage a portfolio of about 160 customers and growing, responsible for teams in the US, Canada and Uruguay. I review the health of the portfolio, have a pulse on the customers satisfaction and the team every day plus work continuously in improving our delivery practice.

What skills are needed for the ACS practice manager role?

Consulting and management experience are a must. Able to strategize the changes required in the practice, processes, delivery to a greater team performance, customer satisfaction and ultimate revenue growth.

"I love our very collaborative and supportive culture. While being better every day in the product, we create the future by listening the ideas of everyone. It is fascinating!

How does a week look like for me?

I am the Functional Consultant in 10-12 Client Accounts with different levels of complexity. Some of my accounts have multiple subsidiaries, operating in different countries and multiple currencies.

What skills are needed for the ACS Consultant role?

It is very important to study and develop product knowledge. Be curious & have initiative. Communicate well to understand client requests. Customers love Problems solved.

"I love the bubbly work environment - it is very interactive. We have extensive access to training and gain experience very quickly".

What is my role in Oracle NetSuite?

As a Project Manager at NetSuite, I manage mostly ERP implementation projects.

I manage scope, timeline, budget, resources, risks, and communications of internal NetSuite teams (Consultants, Account Managers, Delivery Leads, and Support), and clients for the AMP industry.

How does a week look like for me?

I manage between 8 and 10 ERP and related projects simultaneously in different phases and complexities.

What challenges did I overcome?

Took me 9 months to land my first job.

What is my role in Oracle NetSuite?

Practice Manager within AMP vertical I manage projects portfolio for ERP implementations, including project staffing, team utilization and escalations.

Responsible for delivery of projects, budget, people management, and performance.








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
